

Declaration of Soldier for Disability Pension.

Act of June 27, A. D. 1890.

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State of North Carolina, County of Wake, ss:

ON THIS 9 day of July, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety

and that said disability is of a permanent character and is not the result of his own vicious habits.

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above in the

Ordinance Department at Pittsburg Pa. during the Mexican (Here state what the

War. service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above and the dates at which it began and ended.)

He therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under

the Act of Congress approved June 27, A. D. 1890.

He hereby revokes all former powers of attorney, and appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation,
