


Jack of the *Atlanta*Blue with white stars

## **June 1863**

The CSS Atlanta leaves Savannah for Wassau Sound to do battle with the USS Weehawken and Nahant. The Atlanta started its life as the blockade runner Fingal. After making it through the Union blockade with supplies, the FIngal was trapped in Savannah and so was bought by the Confederate Navy. Turned into the ironclad vessel Atlanta, she has the "casemate" that was common on most Southern ironclads. Northern warships used a turret instead. The casemate allowed several guns to fire at once--but you had to turn the whole ship to aim the guns. A turret allowed a ship to fire from any angle--but you had only one or two guns. Atlanta lost its battle with the Yankee ships--and ended up as USS Atlanta for the rest of the war.
